Introduction

The aim of the Treo Eile Thoroughbred Performance Class is to demonstrate the potential of the Thoroughbred horse and the suitability of ex-racehorses in a second career ; rideability, scope, versatility and suitability for the amateur & professional rider. Overview of classes as follows:

Age of Horses & Riders

Horses eligible to compete must be 5-year-olds (foaled in 2020) or over.

Riders must be in their fourteenth year or over.

Format of Classes

- *Intermediate Thoroughbred Performance – 90cms
- Open Thoroughbred Performance – 1m

The classes incorporate three phases; Flat Work, Jumping and Suitability & Type Phase.

The competitor will enter the jumping arena, present to the judge, which commences the the Flatwork phase. On completion of the final halt, the competitor proceeds to fence one. Once the competitor has completed the Ridden Phases, they will proceed to strip the horse and present in-hand to the Suitability & Type judge. All three phases will run consecutively.

The jumping course will consist of approximately 6 showjumping fences and 6 cross country style fences.

Prize Money

In each class, prize money is allocated on the following scale:

1 st Place	€500
2 nd Place	€250
3 rd Place	€100
4 th Place	€50
5 th Place	€50
6 th Place	€50

Agria Insurance will also present a winner's rug and merchandise to the prizewinners.

Conditions of Entry:

Horses must be registered with Treo Eile (FREE on www.treoeile.com/register).


All entries must have a Weatherbys or equivalent racing authority passport. The passport must be available for checking at the show.

Horses must be entered using the name as per the Weatherbys or equivalent recognised foreign racing authority passport.

Horses' names must be registered with Weatherbys or equivalent racing authority. Please contact hello@treoeile.com to obtain a naming form at the Weatherbys reduced fee.

Flatwork Phase (50 Marks)

The Flat Work Phase will take place within the jumping arena.



Marker	Movement	Requirements
X	Approach the Judge in Walk. At X halt	4-time rhythm. Straight halt, maintained for 3 seconds.
From X	Working Trot, 20m circle left	2-time rhythm, showing correct bend
From X	Working Trot, 20m circle right	2-time rhythm, showing correct bend
At X	Working Canter, 20m circle left	Smooth transition and correct strike off on left lead. 3-time rhythm with correct bend and balance.
Through X	2-3 Trot strides. Canter ½ 20m circle right	Smooth transition and correct strike off on right leg. 3-time rhythm with correct bend and balance
2 nd ½ 20m Circle	Progressive downward transitions through Trot & Walk	Smooth downward transitions, maintaining balance. Well defined trot and walk
X	Halt	Circle right 20m diameter

Proceed directly to fence 1

Marking System	Mark
1. Trot Rhythm, relaxation and natural balance	10
2. Canter Rhythm, suppleness of the back, natural balance, ability to engage the hindquarters	10
3. Walk Rhythm, suppleness of the back, activity, ground cover	10
4. Halt Straight and square halt. Maintained for 3 seconds	10
5. Rideability/Temperament Acceptance & reaction to the Rider's aids	10

to be followed immediately by

Jumping Phase (40 Marks)

Judges are looking for a horse that demonstrates rhythm, fluency, good jumping technique, combined with rideability.

Penalties:

Knock – 5 penalties

1st disobedience – 10 penalties

2nd Disobedience – 15 penalties

3rd Disobedience – Elimination

Fall of horse or rider – Elimination

Riders who misuse the whip in the Jumping Phase will receive 5 penalties. Misuse of the whip is where it is not applied to reinforce a leg / seat aid or is inconsistent with the aids being given. Determination of excessive or misuse of the whip will be at the judge's discretion.

Marking System	Marks
1. Technique The horses desire to be careful over a fence.	10
2. Balance Natural balance and general athleticism/agility.	10
3. Rhythm & Fluency Maintaining a rhythm and tempo.	10
4. Rideability/Temperament General attitude and reaction to rider's aids.	10

Suitability & Type (10 marks)

The Judge will be looking for horses with the attributes to undertake a second career within sport horse disciplines in terms of soundness and engagement.

Suitability & Type The horse is put together in such a way that its conformation will align with training for equestrian activities and soundness.	10
